One single press on the Lock or Unlock buttons to operate the door locks on your car. The Trunk release button must be pressed and held down for 2.5 seconds to open your cars trunk if trunk is wired to the remote start module. BUT, the module that comes with this kit, the CM900 module, is compatible with other Compustar 2way remotes including fancy 2way remotes with the LCD. So, if later on you need longer range 2way remotes then there is no need to buy a new remote starter, all you have to do is buy a 2way remotes kit remove old antenna, plug in new antenna and program the new remotes to the system as indicated in page 5 of the installation manual This module is also compatible with DroneMobile technology. The CM900 module is very small in size and is only good for remote starting automatic transmission vehicles. This module is not alarm upgradable since it does not have the necessary ports, siren port, shock sensor port, etc. The CM900 module has a builtin slot used for the bypass BladeAL or BladeTB by iDatalink. This module also has two additional bypass ports used

for iDatalink ALCA or Fortin bypass modules. Out the box the module is preconfigured and the wiring diagram is underneath the module indicating the default configuration. <http://grandp.ru/userfiles/810dx-manual.xml>

To change the features and Programmable Outputs or POC, you will need the Compustar OP500 or the iDatalink ADSUSB interface. The OP500 is more expensive than the ADSUSB interface. The advantage of the ADSUSB interface is that you can change the POC options and features online and you can also upload the firmware to the bypass module as required for each vehicle. I had to enable two options Double Pulse Unlock and Tach Mode. This remote starter was installed in a 2003 Toyota Corolla which required no bypass module. This cut down on the installation time i had to spend working on this car. I was having mechanic install this product for me and to his surprise the wiring diagram was inaccurate and incomplete. So he contacted the company to ask for additional information and wiring diagram information. They told him that they would not give him that information unless he was hired by compustar to install this item. They told me that I had to pay more money to have it installed. Was told that if I installed it the warranty was void. So much for a good deal. If you plan to program different options, I wish you the best of luck. I have not been able to program longer crank time for my 1995 Chevy. It will start, but as an older throttle body FI it requires 2 cranks on cold mornings. Make sure you have a wiring diagram for your specific vehicle, the proper bypass module for most 1996 and later vehicles, and possibly a couple of relays if you need to change polarity. And be sure you mount the antenna in an area without obstructions, such as on the inside of the windshield. The control unit is small and easy to hide under the dash. And the remotes seem to be well built. Keep in mind that if you want to install this on vehicles with any kind of RFID transponder type factory antitheft system you WILL need a bypass module also. Installed myself experienced mechanic and car stereo tech my only issue was finding the horn wire for my car haha simple fix.

Car wire spool and a straight shot to my horn wire right where it meets the horn. Overall install time was about two hours. I would recommend this product to others if they knew how to install. I gave the tech support a 4 star because although they did fantastic with depiction and description of their wiring harnesses the only resource offered for a cars wiring was "contact a representative". Wish they had a site or something set up to offer a vehicle search site to retrieve it placements of wiring, colors, ect. Although I was able to find one easily online. Also, in order to turn the car the key has to be in the ignition or it will lock the steering wheel I'll find a way around that tho. Had a small issue with setting the time it will stay running stock is 15min I think before shutting down. I gave up on that and just set a timer for 15min before leaving. Otherwise, its going to be a long day. Keep in mind that if you want to install this on vehicles with any kind of RFID transponder type factory antitheft system you WILL need a bypass module also. Instructions are great, I highly recomend printing out a wiring diagram for your vehicals ignition switch and then crossing wires off as you connect them. I would buy again for another car.
